We have put an interim arrangement in place for our safe return to school and we will advertise for the position in the coming weeks.
- Communication: Email and Text-a-Parent will continue to be our way of keeping you up
 to date in the coming weeks and months. The DES advises us to limit what goes in and
 out of the building so we will keep to paperless contact as best we can. With this in mind,

- HSE and DES Guidelines: If we find ourselves in a situation, going forward, where a child or staff member is not in school due to their symptoms- we will not be asking other pupils or staff to stay at home. The HSE Departments of Public Health will be the ones to take action if the person has confirmed Covid-19 infection on testing. This will include HSE advice and guidance on communication to school pupils and staff where needed. We are advised that parents/guardians should contact their G.P. as usual if your child is sick. If your G.P. determines that our child requires a COVID-19 test, then any other household contacts should be removed from the school setting.
- Staff Training: Both Kate and I have reviewed the SEESAW programme over the Summer months, with the view to using it to compliment our teaching if we were to experience a situation similar to the final term of the 2019/2020 school year again. Kate and I have signed up for training on this programme which takes place, after school hours, later this month.

 begin 1st year. We hope the new routines will prove only a small challenge for them and
 that they settle in and enjoy the adventures that await them.
